Report on Twelve-Day Workshop of B.Ed. II Year Learners at IGNOU Learner
Support Centre – 27108, Shri Jai Narain Misra PG College, Lucknow

The twelve-day Workshop for B.Ed. II year learners, which is a compulsory component of the BED Programme, was conducted in the offline mode from 16 June to 27 June 2024 at the Study Centre 27108. The workshop was inaugurated with the recitation of the hymns of Goddess Saraswati by the learners.
